## BAKE FOR BELUGAS

Everyone loves homemade cake and one of the tastiest ways to raise funds for WDC is to hold a bake sale at school or for your friends, family and neighbours. You could even get a whale-shaped cookie cutter from WDC's online shop.

## CLIMB EVERY (VIRTUAL) MOUNTAIN

Use your maths skills to work out how many times you will need to go up and down your stairs to 'climb' the equivalent of your local mountain or hill.

## NON UNIFORM DAY

## PARTY BAG

Instead of giving party bags to guests at your birthday party, ask your parents to make a donation to WDC.

## COLOUR TOMBOLA

Blue for bottlenose, pink for porpoises and white for whales. Collect items of each colour and have a colour tombola and ask 25p or 50p a go.



## TOYS NOT TANKS

Bored with your old toys or books? Have a toy sale at school one lunchtime! Charge each person £1 to take a toy or a book and enjoy something new.



## NAME THE WHALE, DOLPHIN OR PORPOISE

Have a stall at your school or local fair and play the name game. You'll just need a prize and our whale, dolphin or porpoise name sheets.
